A MESSAGE TO OUR COMMUNITY

Throughout 2022, our community transitioned into a post-pandemic environment that allowed us to return to our community policing focus. We continue to engage with our residents, visitors, and businesses to address quality-of-life issues and neighborhood concerns to make Lynchburg an even greater place to be. Over the last year, our staff has performed exceptionally well despite staffing challenges and has provided a high level of professional service with an ever-increasing demand for engagement. Mental health calls for service continued to significantly strain our limited resources. We partnered with Horizon Behavioral Health on several fronts to explore creative solutions to this challenge, while also encouraging our state legislature to overhaul the current mental health laws that place an unsustainable burden on law enforcement.

We were extremely excited to have a ground-breaking ceremony in late 2022 for our new police headquarters. This project has been many years in the making and is now a reality that will come to fruition in the near future. The impact of this project on our department and community cannot be overstated. LPD Begins Transition to New Vehicle Color Scheme

LYNCHBURG, Va. – The Lynchburg Police Department (LPD) is excited to announce that the department is transitioning to a new color scheme for its patrol vehicle fleet.

Effective today, two vehicles with this new color scheme have entered service and will be visible around the city. As additional vehicles reach the end of their lifespan, they will be replaced with vehicles that have this new branding.
