## Community Policing Advisory Group Meeting Minutes

July 8, 2024

### I. Call to Order

Acting Deputy Chief Nick Leger called to order the Community Policing Advisory Group meeting at 4:30 at the LPD West Building Conference Room.

### II. Roll Call

### III. New Business

Acting Deputy Chief Leger stated topics to be covered in the meeting: March 1 through June 30, 2024: **Use of Force Incidents and formal complaints against LPD employees.**

Summary of Use of Force Incidents was presented by Lt. Adam Sexton, Captain Joshua Campbell, and Captain Tim Clements. 10 Use of Force incidents involving 18 officers, 6 demeanor complaints involving 6 officers, and 4 allegations of misconduct.

Chief Zuidema presented a live cam video of the new building site. The parking lot and curbing are in place. The building now has power.

Chief Zuidema reviewed the officer involved shooting incident from June 27, 2024.

Chief Zuidema updated the group on the city-wide curfew that city council has extended through the end of the year. As of the end of June, 48 people have been charged with curfew violations.

The Crisis Intervention Team is partnering with Horizon to provide a 40-hour week-long class for mental health first aid training for members of the LPD. The process is ongoing to implement a co-responder **model program** to be paired with a mental health provider to assist with mental health crises.
